For Brace Class, if the second dog in the brace class is NOT entered in a Regular Class, a (second) \$20.00 "additional entry fee" be paid for him/her (the first \$20 having been for the second entry of that dog which is entered in another class. *Bred-by Exhibitor Class Eligibility – All dogs entered in the Bred-by Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.*

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dogs (7 years of age & under 10 years of age), Veteran Dogs (10 years of age & under 12 years of age)	Veteran Dogs (12 years and older in age)
Veteran Bitches (7 years of age & under 10 years of age), Veteran Bitches (10 years of age & under 12 years of age)	Veteran Bitches (12 years and older in age)

Note: Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible for Veteran Classes at independent specialties and by virtue of winning the class, may compete for Best of Breed.

**COURSING CLASS** (Separated by Sex)—For dogs and bitches who are AKC registered and are confirmed lure coursing champions or open field coursing champions. Titles may be from any recognized coursing organization. NOTE: Exhibitor MUST supply proof of eligibility for the class with entry. A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of the ENTIRE PAGE from either the AKC Awards or FAN magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof and MUST accompany the entry form. Dogs & Bitches will not be entered into this class without proof of title accompanying the entry form. First place winners are eligible for Best of Breed competition provided all AKC eligibility and requirements have been met.

### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION – BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**—“The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner’s records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner’s records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.”

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

**STUD DOG CLASS**—For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get will only be judged on the merits of the Get, while the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the

standard for the breed.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS**—For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. It is not necessary that the Produce be under the same ownership as that of the Brood Bitch. The Brood Bitch may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Brood Bitch Class only at the regular entry fee. The Produce **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Brood Bitch unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with her Produce. Produce will only be judged on the merits of the Produce, while the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the breed.

**BRACE CLASS**—A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at the time of the entry. If a dog which is part of a Brace is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed competition and entered as part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. Please submit Brace entries together.

**THE SELECT AWARD —**

At a specialty often times the number of quality dogs in competition far exceeds the number of top awards available. The judge must choose only one Best of Breed and one Best of Opposite Sex. The awarding of a Select Rosette acknowledges that this animal was under consideration for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex. The judge is indicating his recognition of an exceptional animal who could, on another day, merit a top award. The Saluki Club of America allows for 1 Select Award for every 10 entries to the Best of Breed classes and are to be presented in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex. The judge may, at his discretion, award all or none of the rosettes. Receiving a "Select Award" is, indeed, a significant honor.

◆ **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION** ◆

**Novice Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier. Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, 5580 Centerview Dr., Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.

Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC (919) 816-3776.

**Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.**

◆ **PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES** ◆

The Saluki Club of America Sweepstakes are open to all dogs and bitches six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age, except Champions of Record, which are not eligible. 35% of entry fees will be retained by the club for expenses.

Class divisions are as follows and are separated by sex:

6 months & under 9 months    9 months & under 12 months    12 months & under 18 months

Entry fee in the Sweepstakes is \$20.00 for each dog. All entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class and entries must be made at the same time that the regular entries are made AND ON THE SAME ENTRY BLANK UNDER "ADDITIONAL CLASS." 80% of the Sweepstakes fee in each class becomes the Sweepstakes Fund to be divided among the winners of each class as follows:

FIRST PRIZE – 40%	SECOND PRIZE – 30%
THIRD PRIZE – 20%	FOURTH PRIZE – 10%

◆ **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES** ◆

The Saluki Club of America Veteran Sweepstakes are open to all Salukis, seven years of age and over. Spayed and neutered Salukis shall be eligible for competition. 35% of entry fees will be retained by the club for expenses.

Class divisions are as follows and are separated by sex:

7 years & under 9 years    9 years & under 11 years    11 years & older
