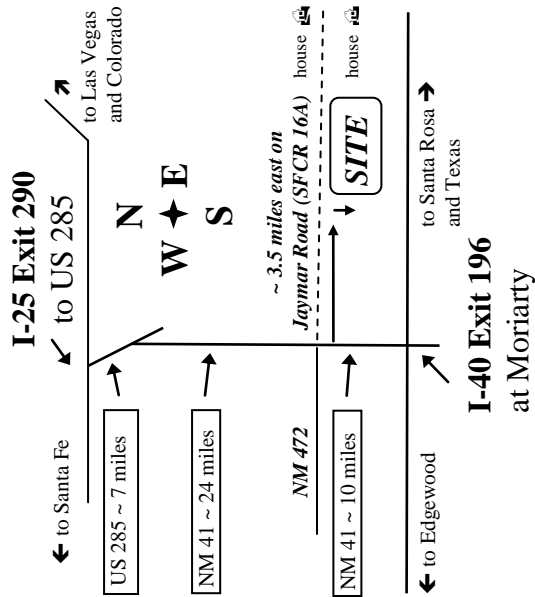

At the intersection of NM 41 and NM 472, turn **EAST** on unpaved Jaymar Road (SFCR 16A) for 3.5 miles.

**TEST/CERTIFICATION/TRIAL HOURS: 7:45 AM until completion.**

**ROLL CALL & INSPECTION (RC&I): JC and QC, 8:15 AM; Trial, 5 minutes after Trial entries close unless completed earlier in the morning.** RC&I for JC, QC, and Trials will be allowed earlier than posted times if inspection team is available.

**DRAW: begins immediately following Trial Roll Call and Inspection.**

**ELIGIBLE BREED AND REGISTRY:** Only purebred Salukis one year of age or older on day of event and have been registered with the American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an AKC ILP/PAL may be entered.

**TESTS OFFERED (JC and QC):**

**JUNIOR COURSER TEST:** Open to all eligible Salukis. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600 yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

**QUALIFYING COURSER CERTIFICATE:** A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed — or another breed with a similar running style — (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. **This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.** The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. Upon successful completion of the Qualified Courser test, the judge completes a certificate and awards it to the handler.

This certificate must be submitted to the host club with the hound’s first entry in an Open Stake. The certificate must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler’s satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

**STAKES OFFERED:**

**OPEN:** Open to all eligible Salukis that have obtained AKC Qualified Courser Certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have run in the Open Class prior to January 1, 2010. This requirement will be waived for ASFA or CKC Field Champions. Copy of Field Champion title certificate must be submitted to host club when entering first AKC Open Stake. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

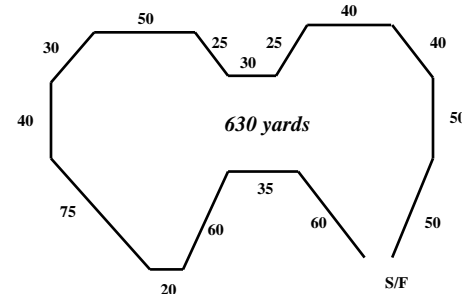
**SPECIAL:** Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship Title. Championship points earned from Specials Stake will count toward LCX titles

**OPEN VETERAN:** Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special Stakes and have reached veteran age (6 years) on the day of the trial. Points earned in Veterans will count toward Field Championship or Lure Courser Excellence titles.

All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The members of the Albuquerque Whippet Fanciers Association reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the event.

**A penalty of \$10 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.**

The SCOA and Stitt Ranch property owners assume no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these Tests/Trials. Please bring your own shade and water, as this is an isolated site.
