DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

SWEEPSTAKES

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

The Saluki Club of America Puppy Sweepstakes are open to all dogs and bitches six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age, Champions of Record are eligible.

Class divisions are as follows and are further divided by sex:

6 months & under 9 months 9 months & under 12 months
12 months & under 15 months 15 months & under 18 months

All entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class and entries must be made at the same time that the regular entries are made AND ON THE SAME ENTRY BLANK UNDER "ADDITIONAL CLASS".

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Saluki Club of America Veteran Sweepstakes are open to all Salukis, seven (7) years of age and over. Spayed and neutered Salukis shall be eligible for competition.

Class divisions are as follows and are further divided by sex:

7 Years & under 10 years 10 Years & older

Salukis in the Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in any other class at this show. Judging will be held prior to the regular breed classes. Entries are made by writing "Veteran Sweepstakes" with age division clearly stated on the entry form.

Sweepstakes Prizes

The SCOA shall retain 35% of the Sweepstakes fund to cover expenses, the remaining fund to be divided among the winners of each class as follows:

FIRST PRIZE - 40% SECOND PRIZE - 20%
THIRD PRIZE - 30% FOURTH PRIZE - 10%

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier. Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL JUNIOR HANDLERS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE AN AKC NUMBER prior to the day of the event. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, call (919) 816-3776. Junior Handlers must put their nine-digit number on the entry blank. Be sure to include all information required on both the front and back of the official AKC entry form.

NOTICE: EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2005, competition is required for awarding of Best in Junior Showmanship. That is, there must be entries in at least two classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

**Veterans Class (divided by Sex). Divisions as follows:
7 Years and Under 10 Years - 10 Years and Older**

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a castrated male or spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran.

Coursing Class (divided by Sex).

For dogs and bitches who are AKC registered and are confirmed lure coursing champions or open field coursing champions Titles may be earned from any recognized coursing organization. NOTE: Exhibitor MUST supply proof of eligibility for the class with entry. A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of the ENTIRE PAGE from either the AKC Awards or FAN magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof and MUST accompany the entry form. First place winners are eligible for Best of Breed competition provided all AKC eligibility and requirements have been met.

Winners of the above class are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

BEST OF BREED

(No defeated dogs will be allowed to compete)

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class: For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of two of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with two of his get and be entered in the Stud Dog class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as for Stud Dog, but replace get for produce.

SPECIAL AWARDS

Award of Merit: At a specialty often times the number of quality dogs in competition far exceeds the number of top awards available. The judge must choose only one Best of Breed and one Best of Opposite Sex. The awarding of a Award of Merit Rosette acknowledges that this animal was under consideration for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex. The judge is indicating his recognition of an exceptional animal who could, on another day, merit a top award.

The Saluki Club of America allows for 5 award of merits to be presented in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex. The judge may, at his discretion, award all or none of the rosettes. Receiving an Award of Merit is, indeed, a significant honor.

A Recording Fee of 50¢ per dog and a Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry, \$3.00 Rally fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards, do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretaries will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. This club and its Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready for judging. In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dogs presence is needed in the judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler to bring his dog into the ring.

It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds.

Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Secretaries Office advised at once. The Secretaries and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

Trophies and Prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of judging, any discrepancies must be reported to the Secretary prior to completion of judging. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest Conformation judging or one half hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.
