Rosettes & Trophies

First Place: Blue, Second Place: Red, Third Place: Yellow, Fourth Place: White, NBQ (Next Best Qualified): Dark Green, Best of Breed: Purple & Gold. Trophies will be awarded for 1st through NBQ and any Non-Regular Stake winners. First placement in each stake also receives a SCOA medallion. The Best of Breed winner is awarded the ASFA Best of Breed SCOA National Specialty Plaque and the SCOA Pyramid Cup (perpetual trophy).

Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Salukis that are one year of age or older on the day of the trial may be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA board approved registry, or possess a critique case number from the Society for the Perpetuation of Desert Bred Salukis.

Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, or late entries will NOT be accepted. Substitutes for lame or in-season hounds are allowed if the substitute has the same owner and the Field Trial Secretary is notified by noon Friday, June 11th 2010. Entries will NOT be acknowledged by mail or telephone.

Owners must keep their hounds under control and clean up after them. A \$10 fine will be assessed for any hound loose on the field not competing in the course in progress.

Stakes Offered

Open: Any eligible Saluki that has met the certification requirements at the time of closing, excluding ASFA Field Champion Salukis of record.

Field Champion: Any ASFA Field Champion Saluki.

Veteran Stake: Any eligible Saluki whose age exceeds six years, who has met certification requirements at the time of closing.

Breeder Stake: Any two Salukis bred by the same person and designated at the time of entry.

Kennel Stake: Any two Salukis owned and kenneled by the same person and designated at the time of entry.

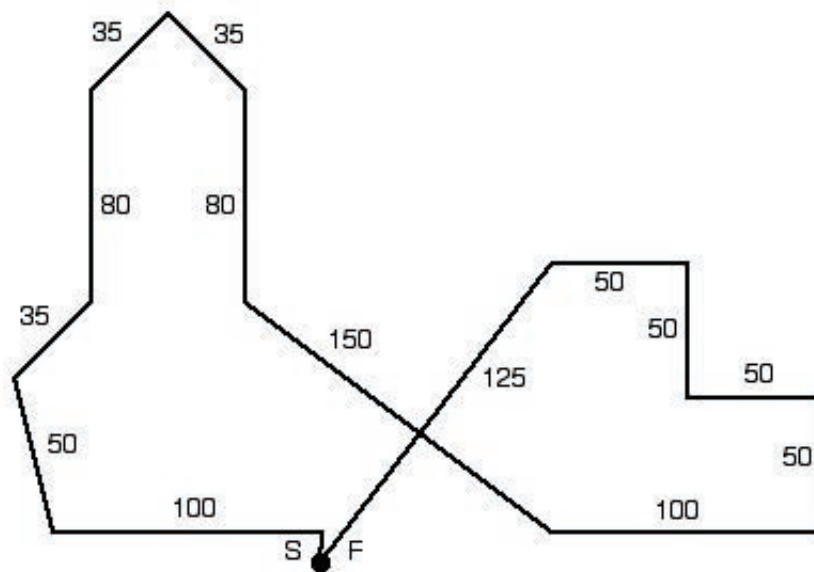
Conditions of Entry:

All entries must be one year old on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split if 20 or more entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw. Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Spayed, neutered, monorchid, and cryptorchid hounds may be entered. A battery powered, continuous loop machine will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips.

The course will be reversed for finals, tie run-offs and BOB. SCOA reserves the right to alter the course as required by weather and/or field conditions.

Hound Certification Runs will not be offered the day of the trial.
Hound Certification Runs are offered on Thursday, June 10th 2010.

From the Kentucky Horse Park (approx 15 mins), turn right (west) out of the Horse Park onto Ironworks Pike. Proceed west on Ironworks approximately 1 mile to where Ironworks Pike dead ends at yellow caution signal at Route 25 (Lexington Road). Turn right on Rt. 25 (north). Proceed approx 5 miles into Georgetown. Central Kentucky Veterinary Center is on your right (blue sign) just past the stoplight at Blockbuster-Kroger entrance.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

The new field location is fenced with horse slat board fencing and not any type of chain link. Additional snow fencing will be used on the side of the field that is near the Interstate. Please make note of this when deciding to enter.

The FTS only has a PO Box, so please note that all entries will have to be sent via the USPS. Please take note of the early closing date of May 19th 2010, and mail your entries via the USPS appropriately. In addition, the FTS will be leaving for the Saluki National no later than Saturday morning, June 5th 2010. Your entries will need to be mailed and received at his PO Box by Friday, June 4th 2010. The FTS will be onsite at the KHP Monday morning, June 7th 2010 to accept any last minute entries.

Lastly, all lure coursing entries (Singles Stake, AKC events, Puppy Fun Run, and ASFA trial) must be sent to the FTS!
