Only Salukis that are between the age of 3 months and 12 months on the day of the event may be entered. Salukis will run alone only once.

Certification Runs And Practice: Thursday, June 10th 2010

Hours: At the completion of SCOA Puppy Fun Run for approximately 2-3 hours (depending on participation levels).

Entires will NOT be acknowledged by mail.

Owners must keep their hounds under control & clean up after them.

STAKES OFFERED

Singles: Open to any Saluki one year of age or older on the date of the event.

3-6 Month Puppy: Open to any Saluki that is between the age of 3 months and 6 months on the date of the event.

6-9 Month Puppy: Open to any Saluki that is between the age of 6 months and 9 months on the date of the event.

9-12 Month Puppy: Open to any Saluki that is between the age of 9 months and 12 months on the date of the event.

Conditions of Entry:

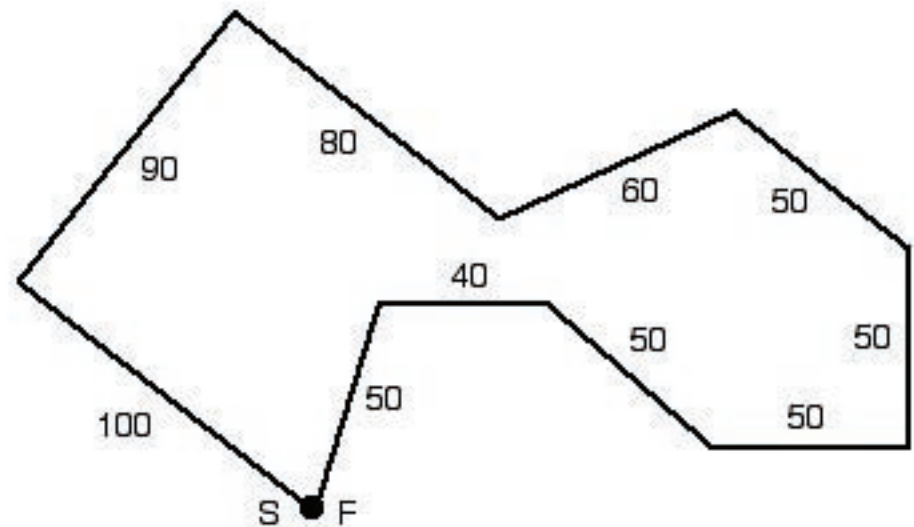
SCOA Saluki Singles: Salukis will run alone only once, unless tied (scored by the ASFA system). Ties for 1st thru 5th will be run off with the Salukis running alone. The course will be a minimum of 600 yards. The course will be reversed for tie runs.

SCOA Puppy Fun Run: Salukis will run alone only once. The 3-6 month puppies will run the small box only of the course plan. The 6-9 month puppies will run the large box only of the course plan. The 9-12 month puppies will run the entire course plan.

Bitches in-season and lame hounds will be excused. Neutered and monorchid hounds may be entered. A battery powered, continuous loop machine will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips. A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose on the field not competing in the course in progress. Any person, upon reasonable complaint, will be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee and will forfeit any entries and fees.

620 yards



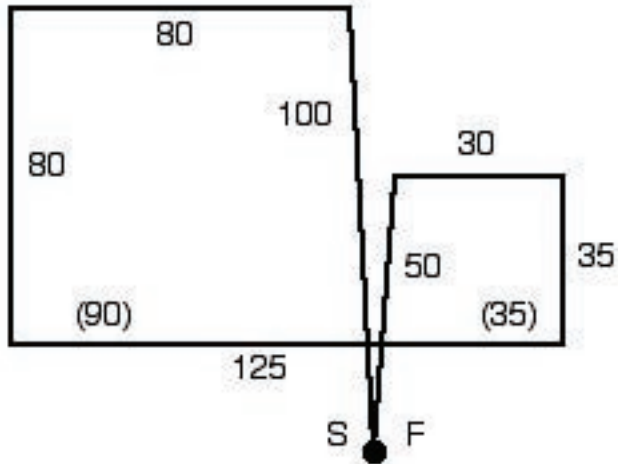
SCOA PUPPY FUN RUN COURSE PLAN

6-9 Month Puppies: 350 yards maximum

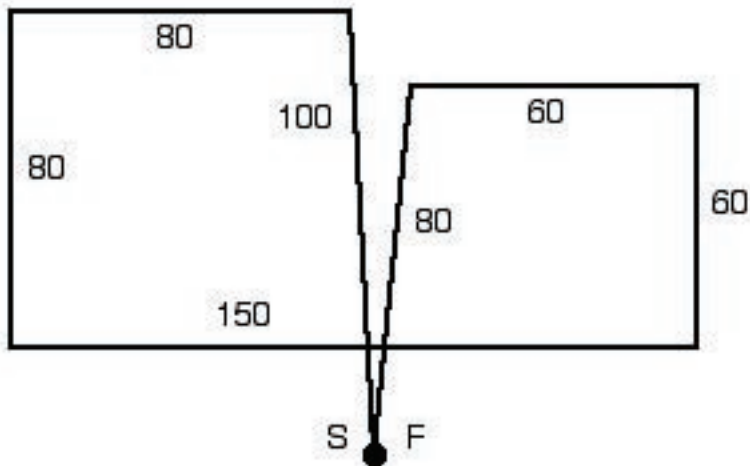
9-12 Month Puppies: 500 yards maximum

From the Kentucky Horse Park (approx 15 mins), turn right (west) out of the
Horse Park onto Ironworks Pike. Proceed west on Ironworks approximately 1
mile to where Ironworks Pike dead ends at yellow caution signal at Route 25
(Lexington Road). Turn right on Rt. 25 (north). Proceed approx 5 miles into
Georgetown. Central Kentucky Veterinary Center is on your right (blue sign)
just past the stoplight at Blockbuster-Kroger entrance.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

The new field location is fenced with horse slat board fencing and not any type
of chain link. Additional snow fencing will be used on the side of the field that
is near the Interstate. Please make note of this when deciding to enter.

The FTS only has a PO Box, so please note that all entries will have to be sent
via the USPS. Please take note of the early closing date of May 19th 2010,
and mail your entries via the USPS appropriately. In addition, the FTS will be
leaving for the Saluki National no later than Saturday morning, June 5th 2010.
Your entries will need to be mailed and received at his PO Box by Friday, June
4th 2010. The FTS will be onsite at the KHP Monday morning, June 7th 2010
to accept any last minute entries.

Lastly, all lure coursing entries (Singles Stake, AKC events, Puppy Fun Run,
and ASFA trial) must be sent to the FTS!
