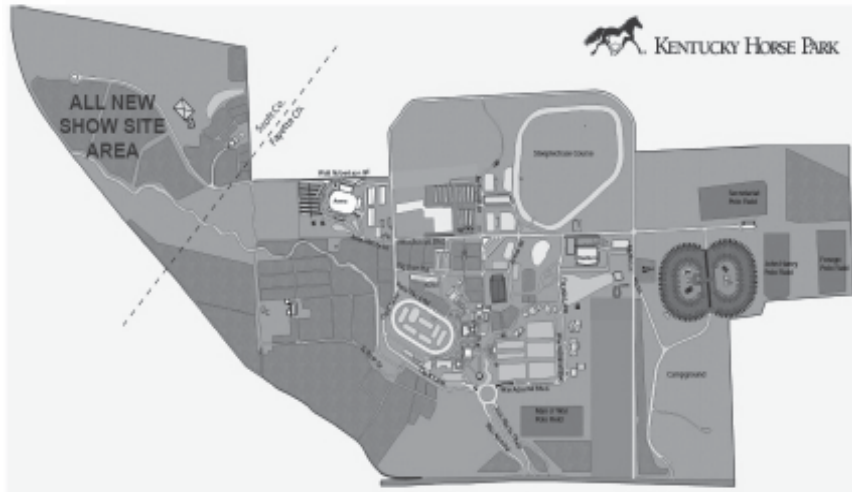

If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes will be collected. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY-The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

COURSING CLASS (Separated by Sex)-For Dogs & Bitches that are AKC registered and are confirmed Lure Coursing Champions or open Field Coursing Champions. Titles May be from any recognized coursing organization. **NOTE:** Exhibitors MUST supply proof of eligibility for the class with entry. A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of the ENTIRE PAGE from either the AKC Awards or FAN magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof and MUST accompany the entry form. Dogs & Bitches will not be entered into this class without proof of title accompanying the entry form. First place winners are eligible for Best of Breed Competition provided all AKC eligibility requirements have been met.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

GRAND CHAMPION

On May 12, 2010 the new AKC Grand Champion competition will be included in all shows offering Best Of Breed or Best Of Variety competition. Once the judge has selected Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite, if quality warrants, the judge may choose a Select Dog and Select Bitch from the remaining Champions in the Best Of Breed ring (Best Of Winners, Winners Dog or Winners Bitch are not considered). At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite, Select Dog, and/or Select Bitch.

AWARD OF MERIT

At a specialty often times the number of quality dogs in competition far exceeds the number of top awards available. The judge must choose only one Best of Breed and one Best of Opposite Sex. The Awarding of a Select Rosette acknowledges this animal was under consideration for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex. The judge is indicating recognition of an exceptional animal who could, on another day, merit a top award. The Saluki Club of America allows for 10 Select Award to be presented in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex. At the judge's discretion, all or none of the Rosettes may be awarded. Receiving an "Award of Merit" is, indeed, a significant honor.

BEST PUPPY

After Best of Breed is chosen, the winners of Puppy Dog 6 months & under 9 months, Puppy Dog 9 months & under 12 months, Puppy Bitch 6 months & under 9 months, and Puppy Bitch 9 months & under 12 months compete for Best Puppy. If the entry has been defeated by another puppy (Winners or Reserve), the entry is not eligible to compete for Best Puppy. If Best of Winners is from either the 6-9 month or 9-12 month class, that entry is automatically Best Puppy.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR

After Best of Breed is chosen, the winners of Bred By Exhibitor Dog and Bred By Exhibitor Bitch compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from the Bred by Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class-For Stud Dogs and two to four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee, and shown in the ring with his Get. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. Entry will be judged on the merits of the Get; while the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the breed. Castrated dogs are eligible for Stud Dog

Brood Bitch Class-For Brood Bitches and two to four of their Produce. It is not necessary that the Produce be under the same ownership as that of the Brood Bitch. The Brood Bitch may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Brood Bitch Class only, and shown in the ring with her produce. The Produce MUST be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes. The Brood Bitch unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. Entry will be judged on the merits of the Produce; while the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the breed. Spayed bitches are eligible for Brood Bitch.

Brace Class-Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of the entry. If a dog which is part of a Brace is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed competition and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. Please submit Brace entries together.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. **BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.** A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier. Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes.
