Dogs Eligible To Enter

This agility trial is open to all Salukis over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs of a registerable breed with an acceptable foreign registration number are eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules. Mixed breeds, breeds not registerable with the AKC, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate.

AKC Jump Height Cards

Jump Height Card copies are not required with your entry. However, you MUST mark on your entry what type of card you have or if you need to be measured at the trial. Please remember, original jump cards MUST be carried at the trial. All dogs that do not have a height card will be required to be measured by the judge of record on the morning of the trial. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial only

Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title after the close of entries; provided that the request is made in writing to the **Trial Secretary** and received no later than **6:00 PM (EST), Tuesday, June 1, 2010**. Move ups will be accepted only under the condition that there is space available in the class moving up to. Please use one form per Move-Up per dog. Following is a sample Move Up form. All information indicated is required to process a Move-Up request.

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Class Information

Standard Agility Classes:

Novice A—For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title.

Novice B—For dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards the Open Agility title, persons who have handled a dog to an agility title, agility judges.

Open—For dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility titles, but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.

Excellent A—Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Master Excellent title.

Excellent B—Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent title.

Jumpers with Weaves Classes:

Novice A JWW—For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title.

Novice B JWW—For dogs that have acquired any agility title but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards the Open JWW title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, agility judges.

Open JWW—For dogs that acquired the Novice JWW or Open JWW titles, but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards the Excellent JWW title.

Excellent A JWW—Open to dogs that have acquired the Open JWW title and to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW title, but have not acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Mast Excellent JWW title.

Excellent B—For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent JWW and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent JWW title.

Preferred Classes:

Preferred classes are offered at all levels per AKC rules. Novice, Open, Excellent A & Excellent B. All dogs must start in the Novice Preferred class regardless of AKC agility title level already earned. The owner may choose to enter the preferred Standard and the Preferred JWW classes in lieu of entering the regular classes at any trial. HOWEVER, the dog must be entered ONLY in the preferred classes or in the regular classes with NO crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. Owners/dogs are allowed to switch back and forth between the preferred classes and the regular classes, but not at the same set of trials. Preferred is scored identical to the Regular classes except 5 seconds is added to the SCT. Visit www.akc.org for a complete set of rules.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered at the trial.

Regular Classes

Obstacles & Exhibitor Information

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

All exhibitors and/or handlers are responsible for entering dogs in the proper height classification. In the Regular classes dogs may run in a higher height division, but not a lower height division than their measured height division. In the Preferred Class dogs MUST jump their measured height division.

At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat, buckle collars, but there shall be NO hanging tags or attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Exhibitors may wear shirt or insignia of their training group if they wish.

No excessive training on the grounds will be tolerated. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors must NOT use the warm-up area as an exercise area for their dogs.

Express Mail Entries (or any Delivery Service) must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address **without** the recipient's signature. If no recipient is present to sign the receipt, entries may be returned to the sender.

Bitches In Season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$8.00, upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary not later than 8AM on the day of the Trial.

Make Checks and Money Orders payable to SCOA. **No refund** for duplicate entries

CANADIAN and all FOREIGN Exhibitors must make Fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. SCOA assumes no responsibility for Cash sent through the mail.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.

Declination of Entries. Saluki Club of America may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the SCOA or any official thereof.

No Entry Shall be Made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Errors on Entry Forms. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Please **TYPE or PRINT** Carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

Entries Will be Acknowledged After Entries Close with a Judging Program. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Secretary.

Entry Fees Shall Not be Refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Agility Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Exhibitors Are Governed by Any Rules or Regulations of Civil Authorities and/or building or location restrictions.

Dogs Must Be Ready for Judging. SCOA will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

All Dogs Present Must be Held on a Leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or in the Warm-up area.

Exhibitors Alone are Responsible for the Behavior of Their Dogs and/or Children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Show Site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made. Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their own dogs.

Puppies under the age of six months are strictly prohibited within the Trial grounds.

AVMA Health Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial **or back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
